Scholars are paired with mentors who assist LEGACY scholars in acquiring the knowledge and skills to become effective students, purposeful leaders, and involved citizens. Although each relationship is different, all mentors work to keep their LEGACY scholars moving forward by smoothing out some of the rough places, cutting through some of the "red tape," and serving as comforters when tasks seem impossible.

LEGACY Scholars gain unique experiences by attending seminars and workshops, participating in networking events and socials, and engaging in community partnerships to enhance their personal and professional development.
